Chapter 25. Deferred Compensation [AMENDED]

SUMMARY:

Additions, revocations and amendments are proposed necessitating permanent rulemaking action. The agency is considering proposals which are designed to make the administration of the Deferred Compensation Plan more efficient and member service oriented. The topics include the distribution of rollover contributions.
