

**TITLE 590. OKLAHOMA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM
CHAPTER 25. DEFERRED COMPENSATION**

RULEMAKING ACTION:

Notice of proposed PERMANENT rulemaking

PROPOSED RULES:

Chapter 25 - Deferred Compensation [AMENDED]

SUMMARY:

Additions, revocations and amendments are proposed necessitating permanent rulemaking action. The agency is considering proposals which are designed to make the administration of the Deferred Compensation Plan more efficient and member service oriented. The topics include amending the time period for elections or deferrals to comply with the Internal Revenue Code and an amendment to allow for electronic signatures and forms.
