SUMMARY:

Amendments are proposed necessitating permanent rulemaking action. The agency is considering proposals which are due to changes in state law. The amendment to 590:1-1-9 is necessary to specify when certain OPERS Board Members are permitted to designate an individual to appear in their place and the amendment to 590:1-3-2 is necessary to include the Oklahoma Defined Contribution System as an eligible plan to participate in Administrative Hearings before the Board.
