The amendment to 590:25-3-5 updates the allowable catchup contributions to comply with the federal SECURE 2.0 legislation. The amendment to 590:25-9-9 clarifies how benefits are paid in the event of the death of the member. The amendment to 590:25-9-16 allows the member to complete in-plan Roth conversions. The amendment to 590:25-9-23 is to comply with the federal SECURE 2.0 legislation.
